- **Experience silence as a portal.**


WHO:

WHAT:

This one-day **CYBERCircle of Trust** is an in-person on-line retreat, offering the opportunity to move into 2022 with intention and attention as we stand at the intersection of our learning from the past year and the sense of not-knowing what's around the next curve.

Our online time will include time in the large group, time in small groups, and time in reflection. Invitations for that time and our time in silence will be offered in the spirit of creating the best chance to fully experience our indivisibility and to glimpse silence as a portal to our connectedness:

What has been an ancient spiritual truth is now increasingly confirmed by science: We are all indivisibly part of one another. We share the same ancestry with everyone and everything alive. The air we breathe contains atoms that have passed through the lungs of ancestors long dead. Our bodies are composed of the same elements created deep inside the furnaces of long-dead stars.
